

CAPITAL FOOTBALL VOLUNTEER ACCEPTANCE FORM

Terms:

In accepting the Position described above, I agree:

1. to give my voluntary services to the Football Federation Australia Limited (**FFA**), to the best of my abilities, with due care and skill and in accordance with any FFA directions and policies notified from time to time;
2. to wear the apparel or uniform as provided by FFA while performing the volunteer services;
3. that I will be reimbursed expenses directly relating to my volunteer services only if I have obtained the prior written consent of FFA and submit appropriate receipts or documentation;
4. to keep confidential all information or material concerning FFA or its competitions or teams, including team movements, player information and any other information specified by FFA as confidential. This obligation survives the expiry or termination of my appointment for any reason;
5. to presently assign to FFA all existing and future intellectual property rights in materials, works or other deliverables created by me (whether on my own or with FFA or its contractors or volunteers) in the course of supplying voluntary services (**Deliverables**) and, in relation to any moral rights I may have, I consent to FFA performing all acts necessary or desirable to enable FFA to fully exploit Deliverables, and not attributing me as the author of Deliverables. I will, on request by FFA from time to time, supply to FFA one copy of the Deliverables in their then current state;
6. to safeguard my personal property (such as bags and money) and acknowledge that FFA is not responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged personal property;
7. that I will not do anything to compromise my safety or the safety of others and I understand that there may be risks associated with providing particular volunteer services;
8. not to use, or refer to, the names or logos of FFA or its competitions or teams without FFA's prior written consent, including in public speaking activities or promotions. I agree not to speak to the media on any issue relating, directly or indirectly, to FFA or my Position;
9. not to bring any claim or proceeding against FFA for any damage, loss, injury or liability I may suffer in carrying out the duties of my Position. Except for liability that by law cannot be excluded, FFA excludes all liability to me in tort (including negligence), contract or bailment for acts or omissions of FFA, its employees and contractors arising out of or in relation to my Position;
10. to comply with FFA's rules and regulations, including the FFA Spectator Code of Behaviour, Terms of Admission, Code of Conduct and Member Protection Policy (copies of which are available on www.footballaustralia.com.au or on request);
11. FFA may terminate my appointment as a volunteer at any time by notice in person or sent to an address above, including if I do not comply with these Terms or engage in serious misconduct; and
12. on the termination or expiry of my appointment, to return all FFA property, including confidential information, accreditation and, where indicated, uniform.
