Dear Heather

I write to advise that ACT Government has given approval to a further temporary use of the public land adjacent to mpowerdome to assist with overflow parking throughout the 2012 National Futsal Championships.

The approval comes with some added requirements for mpowerdome this year to ensure that we are exercising our full duty of care to the public and that all surrounding areas are given the respect they are due. Consequently Roads ACT are providing "No Parking" signage to assist the five mpowerdome staff that have been appointed under the Act (Australian Road Rules (304) 1999, Section 19), to obtain public compliance. The relevant staff understand that professionalism, courtesy and common sense are the manner in which each will go about managing traffic flow and parking throughout the Event. Should people disregard the directions of our staff they will be informed that the police may attend randomly throughout the day and book anyone disregarding the signage. Further, there is an insurance implication for mpowerdome, if a member of the public is injured as a result of traffic or parking disregard.

The public's compliance with the above could possibly affect the level of cooperation that I am hoping for when I meet with ACT Govt on 8 February to discuss a resolve for the more long term parking needs, for which you supplied a letter of support. We remain committed to providing visitors to mpowerdome with a professional and positive experience throughout the Event. Toward this end, it would be of great assistance if you could advise the relevant Capital Football Event Manager of the above so that interstate team managers and their accompanying persons are informed, prior to the Event, of the need to heed the signage and comply with the directions of the mpowerdome traffic and parking attendants.

Thanks for your assistance and here's to another great National Futsal Championships.
